## Special Economic Zone - tax exemptions up to 70%!

- The highest state aid on a national scale for entrepreneurs with permits to conduct business activities in the Warmia and Mazury

  Special Economic Zone
- income tax exemption at the level of 50%, increased by an additional 10% in the case of medium-sized enterprises, in the case of small enterprises by an additional 20%
- exemption for a new investment or job creation - freedom to choose the title you want to use;

## Low local tax rates

- 84% of the maximum rate:
   PLN 0.75 per 1 m2 from the area of land related to running a business PLN 19.32 per 1 m2 of usable floor space for buildings or parts thereof related to business activities and residential buildings or parts thereof used for business purposes
- 2-year real estate tax exemption for newly built and extended buildings

## Convenient location

- proximity to the eastern border of the European Union - 70 km to the border crossing with Russia, Lituania, Belarus, Ukraine
- location at the intersection of two main communication routes in the region, close to Baltic see ports
- 60 km to the nearest airport Olsztyn -Mazury
- 220 km to the international airport (Gdańsk, Warsaw) and the seaport
